2 Future in the Past: Grammar Focus

A. What is Future in the Past?

Talking about plans, intentions, or expectations made in the past, often using:

- ✓ was/were going to
- ✓ was/were supposed to
- was/were to have + past participle

B. "Was/Were Supposed To"

- Version Meaning: There was an expectation, but it might not have happened.
- Structure: was/were supposed to + base verb
 Examples:

I was supposed to call her yesterday.

They were supposed to arrive at 7, but they were late.

C. "Was/Were To Have + Past Participle"

- 🔽 Meaning: A formal structure often used in reporting.
- Structure: was/were to have + past participle
 Examples:

The meeting was to have started at 9 am. They were to have finished the work by Monday.
