Climb	verb	To rise or go up slowly or steadily
Considerable	adjective	Large in amount or importance
Decline	verb / noun	A gradual decrease
Decrease	verb / noun	To become smaller or less / a reduction
Dramatic	adjective	Very noticeable or big
Drop	verb / noun	To fall / a decrease
Enormous / Huge	adjective	Very large
Fall	verb / noun	To go down / a decrease
Grow	verb	To become larger or greater over time
Improve	verb	To get better
Increase	verb / noun	To become larger or greater / a growth
Minimal	adjective	Very small or slight
Moderate	adjective	Not too much or too little; average
Peak	noun / verb	The highest point / to reach the highest point
Rapid	adjective	Fast or quick
Reduce	verb	To make smaller in size or amount
Remain stable	verb phrase	To stay the same without big changes
Rise	verb / noun	To go up / an increase
Sharp	adjective	Sudden and noticeable
Significant	adjective	Important or large enough to notice
Slight	adjective	Small or not very noticeable
Steady	adjective	Consistent, not changing suddenly
Substantial	adjective	Significant or considerable
Sudden	adjective	Happening quickly and unexpectedly
Trend	noun	A general direction in which something is developing or changing
